The Little Boy Who Could



Tazzie and his sister, Tazzara, came to Tazz and Margie Barba's family as foster children at six months and eighteen months old, respectively. Not long after, they received a phone call saying that Tazzie had missed an important doctor's appointment. The children had a history of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy (DMD) in their family and Tazzie needed to have tests run to check if he had the gene.

Unfortunately, Tazzie did have the gene for DMD and his need for ongoing medical treatment began early in his life.

Tazz and Margie then received a

second unexpected call asking if they were willing to adopt Tazzie and Tazzara. Margie recalls the conversation and how knowing the struggles Tazzie would face factored into her and her husband's decision. "We're not letting them go."

Tazzie and Tazzara's adoption was official within a year.

Part of Tazzie's treatment plan came to include frequent infusions. The closest location to their Odessa home was at Midland Memorial Hospital. Since 2021, the family has gone to the hospital every week for this treatment.

The Ronald McDonald Family Room at Midland Memorial opened last year in 2022. Margie says that she didn't find the Family Room; the Family Room found her. She recalls her first meeting with the Family Room Coordinator who came by the hospital room to greet the family and bring Tazzie a wooden dinosaur. The family was invited to come by the Family Room whenever they wanted to grab a snack, play, or take a break.

Going to the Family Room after Tazzie's infusion became a ritual for the family. Tazzie got to play a little and get a snack and his parents could relax. It gave the family time to decompress and step away from the hospital environment before they started the trip back home. Tazzie felt at home and made art to hang up in the Family Room, "He was so excited, leaving the hospital room and going to deliver his drawing."

For Tazzie's 6th birthday party at the hospital this past year, he received two gifts from RMHC
